HOUSE BILL NO. 700

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-7-34, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 PROVIDE THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF YEARS IMPOSED UNDER POST-RELEASE
 SUPERVISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE MAXIMUM SENTENCE AUTHORIZED TO BE
 IMPOSED BY LAW FOR CERTAIN FELONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 SECTION 1. Section 47-7-34, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 amended as follows:

8 47-7-34. (1) When a court imposes a sentence upon a 9 conviction for any felony committed after June 30, 1995, the 10 court, in addition to any other punishment imposed if the other punishment includes a term of incarceration in a state or local 11 correctional facility, may impose a term of post-release 12 supervision. However, the total number of years * * * of 13 post-release supervision shall not exceed the maximum sentence 14 authorized to be imposed by law for the felony committed. 15 The defendant shall be placed under post-release supervision upon 16 17 release from the term of incarceration. The period of supervision shall be established by the court. 18

19 The period of post-release supervision shall be (2)conducted in the same manner as a like period of supervised 20 probation, including a requirement that the defendant shall abide 21 by any terms and conditions as the court may establish. Failure 22 23 to successfully abide by the terms and conditions shall be grounds 24 to terminate the period of post-release supervision and to recommit the defendant to the correctional facility from which he 25 26 was previously released. Procedures for termination and recommitment shall be conducted in the same manner as procedures 27

28 for the revocation of probation and imposition of a suspended 29 sentence.

30 (3) Post-release supervision programs shall be operated
31 through the probation and parole unit of the Division of Community
32 Corrections of the department. The maximum amount of time that
33 the Mississippi Department of Corrections may supervise an
34 offender on the post-release supervision program is five (5)
35 years.

36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after July 1, 2006.
