HOUSE BILL NO. 752

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-9-49, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS TO DEDUCT FROM THE SALARY 2. 3 OF SUPERINTENDENT, PRINCIPAL, TEACHER OR OTHER EMPLOYEE CERTAIN 4 DUES FOR MEMBERSHIP TO PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS; AND FOR RELATED 5 PITRPOSES BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-9-49, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 37-9-49. * * * The superintendent of schools may deduct or 9 permit to be deducted from the salary of any superintendent, 10 principal, teacher or other employee * * * dues * * * payable 11 because of the membership of such superintendent, principal, 12 teacher or other employee in a professional organization or 13 14 association. Such dues deduction may only be made upon written authorization from a superintendent, principal, teacher or other 15 employee. School boards may develop policies and procedures for 16 implementing this voluntary professional organization or 17 association dues deduction process. Dues or premiums in health 18 19 associations or corporations and tax sheltered annuity deductions authorized by the United States Internal Revenue Code may be 20 21 deducted upon written authorization from the superintendent, principal, teacher or other employee involved. Any superintendent 22 of schools who shall make any unauthorized deduction or permit any 23 unauthorized deduction to be made, except those herein provided, 24 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be 25 punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) 26

for each such deduction.
