Any attorney who is appointed as a public б defender to represent juveniles in youth court shall annually 7 obtain a minimum of seven (7) continuing legal education hours on 8 youth court practice and procedures as determined, approved and regulated by The Mississippi Bar. 9

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
