HOUSE BILL NO. 824

 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-5-23, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE CRIME OF FONDLING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
 SECTION 1. Section 97-5-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 amended as follows:

97-5-23. (1) Any person above the age of eighteen (18) 6 7 years, who, for the purpose of gratifying his or her lust, or 8 indulging his or her depraved licentious sexual desires, shall 9 handle, touch or rub with hands or any part of his or her body or any member thereof, any child under the age of sixteen (16) years, 10 11 with or without the child's consent, or a mentally defective, mentally incapacitated or physically helpless person as defined in 12 Section 97-3-97, shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction 13 thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less than One Thousand 14 15 Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or be committed to the custody of the State 16 Department of Corrections not less than two (2) years nor more 17 than fifteen (15) years, or be punished by both such fine and 18 imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. 19

20 (2) Any person above the age of eighteen (18) years, who, for the purpose of gratifying his or her lust, or indulging his or 21 22 her depraved licentious sexual desires, shall handle, touch or rub 23 with hands or any part of his or her body or any member thereof, any child younger than himself or herself and under the age of 24 25 eighteen (18) years who is not such person's spouse, with or without the child's consent, when the person occupies a position 26 of trust or authority over the child shall be guilty of a felony 27 *HR03/R1228* H. and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less 28 29 than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or be committed to the custody of the State 30 Department of Corrections not less than two (2) years nor more 31 32 than fifteen (15) years, or be punished by both such fine and 33 imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. A person in a position of trust or authority over a child includes without 34 limitation a child's teacher, counselor, physician, psychiatrist, 35 psychologist, minister, priest, physical therapist, chiropractor, 36 37 legal guardian, parent, stepparent, aunt, uncle, scout leader or 38 coach.

Any person above the age of eighteen (18) years, who, (3) 39 40 for the purpose of gratifying his or her lust, or indulging his or her depraved licentious sexual desires in the presence of a child 41 under the age of sixteen (16), with or without the child's 42 consent, or in the presence of a mentally defective, mentally 43 44 incapacitated or physically helpless person as defined in Section 45 97-3-97, commits any sexual act that does not involve actual physical or sexual contact with such child or person, shall be 46 47 guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, shall be fined in a sum not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five 48 49 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or be committed to the custody of 50 the State Department of Corrections not less than two (2) years nor more than fifteen (15) years, or be punished by both fine and 51 52 imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. Sexual acts include, but are not limited to, masturbation, exhibition of 53 54 genitals or breasts in a lewd or lascivious manner, 55 sadomasochistic abuse, sexual bestiality, or the simulation of any act involving sexual activity. Nothing in this subsection 56 57 includes verbal assault or verbal contact. 58 (4) Any person above the age of eighteen (18) years, who for 59 the purpose of gratifying his or her lust, or indulging his or depraved licentious sexual desires, commits any sexual act that 60 *HR03/R1228* H. does not involve actual physical or sexual contact with the child 61 62 but commits the act in the presence of a child under the age of eighteen (18) years who is not such person's spouse, with or 63 64 without the child's consent, when the person occupies a position 65 of trust or authority over the child shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less 66 than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five Thousand 67 Dollars (\$5,000.00), or be committed to the custody of the State 68 Department of Corrections not less than two (2) years nor more 69 than fifteen (15) years, or be punished by both such fine and 70 71 imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. Sexual acts include, but are not limited to, masturbation, exhibition of 72 73 genitals or breasts in a lewd or lascivious manner, 74 sadomasochistic abuse, sexual bestiality, or the simulation of any act involving sexual activity. A person in a position of trust or 75 authority over a child includes without limitation a child's 76 77 teacher, counselor, physician, psychiatrist, psychologist, 78 minister, priest, physical therapist, chiropractor, legal 79 guardian, parent, stepparent, aunt, uncle, scout leader or coach. 80 Nothing in this subsection includes verbal assault or verbal 81 contact. 82 (5) Upon a second conviction for an offense under this section, the person so convicted shall be punished by commitment 83 to the State Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed 84 85 twenty (20) years, however, upon conviction and sentencing, the

86 offender shall serve at least one-half (1/2) of the sentence so 87 imposed.

88 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 89 and after July 1, 2006.
