## HOUSE BILL NO. 895

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13	AN ACT TO CREATE A STATEWIDE PROGRAM FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIANS UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI BOARD OF NURSING; TO PROHIBIT ANY PERSON FROM PRACTICING AS A CERTIFIED HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIAN OR USING ANY TITLE TO INDICATE THAT THE PERSON IS A CERTIFIED HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIAN, UNLESS THE PERSON IS CERTIFIED UNDER THIS ACT; TO PRESCRIBE THE POWERS OF THE BOARD OF NURSING REGARDING THE CERTIFICATION OF HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIANS, TRAINING PROGRAMS, CERTIFICATION EXAMINATIONS AND DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS; TO PRESCRIBE THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS FOR CERTIFICATION AS A HEMODIALYSIS TECHNICIAN; TO PRESCRIBE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF NURSING TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN FEES NECESSARY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
15	<b>SECTION 1.</b> (1) A statewide program for certification of
16	hemodialysis technicians is created under the Mississippi Board of
17	Nursing.
18	(2) Unless certified as a certified hemodialysis technician
19	under this section, no person shall:
20	(a) Practice as a certified hemodialysis technician; or
21	(b) Use the title "certified hemodialysis technician,"
22	"hemodialysis technician," or other title, abbreviation, letters,
23	figures, signs, or devices to indicate or imply that the person is
24	a certified hemodialysis technician.
25	(3) The Board of Nursing is authorized and empowered to:
26	(a) Maintain a permanent register of all certified
27	hemodialysis technicians;
28	(b) Adopt rules and regulations for certified
29	hemodialysis technician training programs, including standards and
30	curricula;
31	(c) Provide for periodic evaluation of training
32	programs;
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33 (d) Grant, deny or withdraw approval from a training 34 program that fails to meet prescribed standards or fails to 35 maintain a current contract with the board; 36 (e) Develop, maintain and administer a certification 37 examination, or grant, deny or withdraw approval of a

38 certification examination(s);

39 (f) Adopt rules and regulations for certification of 40 hemodialysis technicians by examination, endorsement, renewal and 41 reinstatement; and

42 (g) Conduct disciplinary hearings of certified
43 hemodialysis technicians concerning the restriction, denial,
44 suspension, revocation and/or discipline of a certificate holder
45 in any manner specified in rules and regulations of the board.

46 (4) Any applicant for certification to practice as a47 hemodialysis technician shall submit to the Board of Nursing:

48 (a) An attested written application on a Board of49 Nursing form;

50 (b) A diploma from an approved high school or the 51 equivalent thereof, as determined by the appropriate education 52 agency;

53 (c) Written official evidence of completion of a 54 hemodialysis technician program approved by the Board of Nursing; 55 (d) Evidence of competence in English related to health 56 care/nursing if the first language is not English;

57 (e) Written official evidence that the applicant has 58 passed the certification examination as approved by the Board of 59 Nursing; and

60 (f) Any other official records required by the Board of61 Nursing.

The Board of Nursing may, in its discretion, refuse to accept the application of any person who has been convicted of a criminal offense under any provision of Title 97 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, or any offense listed in Section 43-11-13(5), or any sex H. B. No. 895 \*HR12/R1300\*

68 (5) Every certificate issued by the Board of Nursing to 69 practice as a certified hemodialysis technician shall be renewed 70 every two (2) years. The certified hemodialysis technician 71 seeking renewal shall submit proof of employment as a certified 72 hemodialysis technician, proof of having met continuing education 73 requirements adopted by the Board of Nursing and any other 74 official records required by the Board of Nursing.

(6) The Board of Nursing shall establish nonrefundable fees necessary for the administration of this section, including, but not limited to, fees for initial certification by initial or later examination, renewal of certification, reinstatement of a lapsed certificate, endorsement, initial review and approval of a training program, and later review and approval of a training program.

82 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 83 and after July 1, 2006.
