COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 919

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO DEFINE CERTAIN TERMS; TO CLARIFY THE PLACEMENT OF BAIT ON PRIVATE 2 3 4 PROPERTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 8 49-7-33. (1) Except as otherwise provided for in this 9 section, it is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild bird or 10 wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of calls of 11 any kind; however a person: 12 (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for 13 hunting coyote and crow; 14 (b) May use liquid scents, salt or trace minerals for 15 16 any animal or bird; and 17 (c) May use lures for trapping furbearing animals, beaver, coyote, fox and nutria according to regulations adopted by 18 19 the commission; (d) May hunt, kill or attempt to take or kill any deer 20 21 or wild turkey over grains, seeds or forage resulting from the natural agriculture practices or supplemental plantings; and 22 23 (e) May hunt or kill deer near or in close proximity to a location where bait has been placed if such location is not 24 25 within the person's sight. (2) For purposes of this section "bait" is considered any 26 27 grain or any other edible feed deposited or scattered so as to 28 constitute an attraction. *HR40/R1160CS* H. B. 29 (3) The commission, in its discretion, may relax the 30 restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a 31 condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of 32 Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or 33 livestock in a certain community, county or area.

34 (4) A person may use bait to trap wild hogs as defined in
35 Section 49-7-140 during the period between the end of Spring
36 turkey season and the beginning of deer season with bow and arrow.
37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
38 and after July 1, 2006.
