HOUSE BILL NO. 932

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-21-87, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REVISE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE
- OPERATION OF MOTORBOATS WHILE TOWING A PERSON ON WATER SKIS, AN AQUAPLANE OR SIMILAR DEVICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 59-21-87, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 59-21-87. (1) No person shall operate a motorboat on any
- 9 waters of this state while towing a person on water skis, or on an
- 10 aquaplane or similar device between one hour after sunset and one
- 11 hour before sunrise.
- 12 (2) Each person being towed behind a vessel on water skis or
- 13 similar devices must wear a properly secured Type 1, II, III or V
- 14 U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device.
- 15 (3) Every vessel except personal watercraft, towing a person
- 16 on water skis or similar device must have:
- 17 (a) A capable observer, other than the operator, ten
- 18 (10) years old or older; or
- 19 (b) A wide-angle rearview mirror at least seventy-eight
- 20 (78) square inches in size and having a field of vision of at
- 21 least one hundred seventy (170) degrees.
- 22 <u>(4) Every personal watercraft towing a person on water skis</u>
- 23 or a similar device must have mirrors mounted on both the right
- 24 and left sides of the personal watercraft, but not attached to the
- 25 steering control, and the mirrors must be at least two and
- one-half (2-1/2) inches high by four (4) inches wide.
- 27 (5) A reasonable distance from other vessels, people and
- 28 property must be maintained so as not to endanger life or

- 29 property. It is illegal to tow a person on water skis or similar
- 30 devices behind a vessel or to manipulate the water skis or similar
- 31 devices in a manner that causes the towed person to collide with
- 32 <u>another person or object.</u>
- 33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2006.
