HOUSE BILL NO. 941

1 AN ACT TO LIMIT THE PRODUCTS THAT MAY BE SOLD THROUGH 2 CERTAIN VENDING MACHINES ON PUBLIC SCHOOL CAMPUSES TO MILK, WATER, 3 100% NATURAL JUICES, FRESH OR DRIED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES AND 4 WHOLE-GRAIN SNACKS; TO EXEMPT SCHOOL DISTRICTS UNDER CONTRACT FOR 5 VENDING SERVICES FROM SUCH REQUIREMENTS UNTIL THE DATE THE VENDING 6 CONTRACT EXPIRES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) In all public schools in this state which 8 have vending machines on campus, only milk, water, one hundred 9 10 percent (100%) natural juices, fresh or dried fruits and vegetables and whole-grain snacks may be sold in such machines. 11 However, the requirements of this section do not apply to vending 12 machines located in faculty or teachers' lounges or locations 13 14 where only adults have access to the machines and vending machines operated only during athletic events. 15

(2) If, on July 1, 2006, a school district is under an 16 17 existing contract with a company to provide vending services, the school district is exempt from complying with subsection (1) of 18 this section, to the extent that the requirements of subsection 19 (1) may violate the terms and conditions of the contract, until 20 the date the contract expires. For purposes of this section, the 21 22 date the contract expires is the ending date of the term of the contract in effect as of July 1, 2006, and does not include any 23 period for which the contract is renewed or extended. After the 24 date that the contract expires, the requirements set forth in 25 subsection (1) are applicable to all schools in that district. 26 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

28 and after July 1, 2006.
