COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 991

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND 2 ADMINISTRATION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, 3 TO SELL CERTAIN STATE-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF 4 JACKSON; TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND PURCHASER OR 5 LESSEE OF THE PROPERTY TO AN ACCEPTABLE USE OF THE PROPERTY; AND 6 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The Department of Finance and Administration, 8 acting on behalf of the Mississippi Department of Education, and 9 10 upon meeting the requirements of Section 29-1-1, may sell and convey all or part of certain state-owned real property in the 11 city of Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi, commonly known as the 12 School for the Blind, more particularly described as follows: 13 A part of Section 24, Township 6 North, Range 1 East, 14 being that property that lies North of Eastover Drive 15 and East of Interstate 55 Frontage Road allocated to the 16 17 Department of Education for use by the School for the Blind, consisting of 20 acres, more or less, exact 18 acreage, easements and boundaries to be determined by an 19 20 official survey.

21 <u>SECTION 2.</u> With regard to the sale or conveyance of all or 22 part of the property described in Section 1 of this act, the owner 23 or lessee shall use the property in a manner as approved by the 24 State Board of Education to be an acceptable use of the property 25 in that the use will not interfere with the operation of the 26 Mississippi School of the Blind.

27 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral 28 rights in the property sold pursuant to this act.
