HOUSE BILL NO. 991

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
2 ADMINISTRATION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION,
3 TO SELL CERTAIN STATE-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF
4 JACKSON.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Department of Finance and Administration,
7 acting on behalf of the Mississippi Department of Education, and
8 upon meeting the requirements of Section 29-1-1, may sell and
9 convey all or part of certain state-owned real property in the
10 city of Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi, commonly known as the
11 School for the Blind, more particularly described as follows:

12 A part of Section 24, Township 6 North, Range 1 East,
13 being that property that lies North of Eastover Drive
14 and East of Interstate 55 Frontage Road allocated to the
15 Department of Education for use by the School for the
16 Blind, consisting of 20 acres, more or less, exact
17 acreage, easements and boundaries to be determined by an
18 official survey.

19 **SECTION 2.** The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral
20 rights in the property sold pursuant to this act.

21 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after its passage.
