SECTION 1. The Public Service Commission shall require

- 9 be known as "farm residential meters." A farm residential meter
- 10 may be utilized, in the discretion of a property owner, on any
- 11 tract of land used for farming or agricultural purposes upon which
- 12 the property owner also resides. An electric utility must operate
- 13 farm residential meters in the same manner as electrical meters
- 14 located on residential property. The electric utility may not
- 15 assess farm residential meter holders a rate for electricity which
- 16 is different from the rate charged for residential ratepayers, and
- 17 the utility may not assess on-demand rates for electricity used by
- 18 farm residential meter holders.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2006.
