1 2 3	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 69-5-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE AND EXPAND THE MISSISSIPPI LIVESTOCK SHOW FROM THREE TO SIX DIRECTORS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 69-5-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	69-5-101. $\underline{(1)}$ In order to encourage and promote the raising
8	of livestock and dairy stock in the state, there is hereby created
9	a body politic and corporate to be hereafter known as "Mississippi
10	Livestock Show" which said body politic and corporate shall be
11	under the management and control of the Commissioner of
12	Agriculture and Commerce, or his designee, to be a nonvoting
13	member, director of extension service, the President of the Future
14	Farmers of America, or his designee, the President of Mississippi
15	Livestock Council and two (2) members elected by the Mississippi
16	Livestock Council, hereinafter designated as directors, who shall
17	serve without compensation. The two (2) members elected by the
18	Mississippi Livestock Council shall be elected annually as
19	follows:
20	(a) One (1) of the members elected by the Mississippi
21	Livestock Council shall be (i) a parent or a grandparent of an
22	exhibitor of a species of animal that is different from the animal
23	species that is exhibited in accordance with paragraph (b) of this
24	subsection; and (ii) shall reside in that part of the State of
25	Mississippi that is north of Highway 80. However, the member
26	elected under this paragraph shall not be a resident of the same

- 27 county as the member elected under paragraph (b) of this
- 28 subsection.
- 29 (b) One (1) of the members elected by the Mississippi
- 30 Livestock Council shall be (i) a parent or a grandparent of an
- 31 exhibitor of a species of animal that is different from the animal
- 32 species that is exhibited in accordance with paragraph (a) of this
- 33 subsection; and (ii) shall reside in that part of the State of
- 34 Mississippi that is south of Highway 80. However, the member
- 35 elected under this paragraph shall not be a resident of the same
- 36 county as the member elected under paragraph (a) of this
- 37 subsection.
- 38 (2) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- 39 2008.
- 40 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 41 and after July 1, 2006.
