HOUSE BILL NO. 1051

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-103-129, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REQUIRE THAT STATE AGENCIES INCLUDE CERTAIN INFORMATION ON 3 CONTRACT WORKERS IN THEIR ANNUAL BUDGET REQUESTS; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6 SECTION 1. Section 27-103-129, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 27-103-129. (1) To enable the Legislative Budget Office to 9 prepare such budget, it shall have full and plenary power and 10 authority to require all general-fund and special-fund agencies and the Mississippi Department of Transportation and the Office of 11 State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi Department of 12 Transportation to file a budget request with such information and 13 in such form and in such detail as it may deem necessary and 14 advisable, and it shall have the further power and authority to 15 16 reduce or eliminate any item or items of requested appropriation by any state agency in the Legislative Budget Office's recommended 17 budget to the Legislature. However, where any item of requested 18 19 appropriation shall be so reduced or eliminated, the head of the 20 agency involved shall have the right to appear before the appropriate legislative committee to urge a revision of the budget 21 to restore the item reduced or eliminated. Beginning with the 22 23 1996 fiscal year, the budget requests shall include a definition of the mission of the agency, a description of the duties and 24 responsibilities of the agency, financial data relative to the 25 26 various programs operated by the agency and performance measures associated with each program of the agency. developed by cooperative efforts of the Legislative Budget Office, 29 the Department of Finance and Administration and the agency itself 30 and shall be approved jointly by the Legislative Budget Office and 31 32 the Department of Finance and Administration prior to inclusion 33 within the agency budget request. Beginning with the 1996 fiscal 34 year, the budget requests shall also include in an addendum format a five-year strategic plan for the agency which shall include, but 35 not be limited to, the following items of information: 36 (a) a comprehensive mission statement, (b) performance effectiveness 37 objectives for each program of the agency for each of the five (5) 38 39 years covered by the plan, (c) a description of significant external factors which may affect the projected levels of 40 performance, (d) a description of the agency's internal management 41 system utilized to evaluate its performance achievements in 42 relationship to the targeted performance levels, (e) an evaluation 43 by the agency of the agency's performance achievements in 44 45 relationship to the targeted performance levels for the two (2) preceding fiscal years for which accounting records have been 46 finalized. 47 48 (2) All agencies that are subject to subsection (1) of this section shall include in their budget requests the following 49

50 information regarding contract workers for the most recently

51 completed fiscal year:

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(a) The name of each worker;

(b) The specific type of services provided;

54 (c) The hourly rate of compensation, or the basis for 55 compensation if a rate other than the hourly rate is used; and 56 (d) The total gross salary or wages paid.

57 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after July 1, 2006.
