COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1056

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-9-55, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REVISE THE OFFENSE OF OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE; AND FOR RELATED 2 3 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 97-9-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 97-9-55 If any persons by force, bribery, promise of reward, 8 abuse, threat or threatening communication, whether oral, written or by telephone or by damaging the real or personal property of 9 such person or public property under his control shall attempt to 10 or shall influence, intimidate, impede, delay, harass or injure 11 12 any grand or petit juror or person called for jury service, witness, informant or any other person in the discharge of his or 13 14 her duties with the intent: 15 (a) To cause such person to falsely testify, or withhold testimony, records or evidence in a criminal proceeding, 16 evade subpoena or be absent from any official proceeding, inquiry 17 18 or investigation; or (b) To hinder, delay, prevent or dissuade such person 19 20 from reporting or prosecuting a crime, forcing or intimidating 21 such person to withdraw or alter criminal charges or make a false affidavit or statement; or 22 23 (c) To hinder, delay, prevent or dissuade any person from reporting a crime or communicating with a law enforcement 24 officer, prosecutor or judge regarding the commission or possible 25 26 commission of a criminal offense; or

27	(d) To hinder, delay, prevent or dissuade any person
28	from investigating, presenting, defending or trying any case or
29	otherwise carrying out his official duties respecting a criminal
30	case; or
31	(e) If any person or persons retaliate against a
32	witness, party or informant in an official proceeding by threat,
33	bodily injury, harassment or damage to real or personal property
34	belonging to or under the control of such person.
35	If any person or persons shall destroy, mutilate, alter,
36	conceal or fail to produce any evidence under his control or
37	possession or fail to reveal the whereabouts of evidence which is
38	known to him.
39	Then such person shall be guilty of obstruction of justice
40	and may be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not
41	more than one (1) year or a fine of not more than One Thousand
42	Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both, or may be imprisoned not more than
43	five (5) years in the State Penitentiary or fined not more than
44	Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or both.
45	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
46	and after July 1, 2006.
