HOUSE BILL NO. 1059

AN ACT TO SPECIFY THE RIGHTS OF EMPLOYERS REGARDING THE

2 TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS IN LOCKED VEHICLES ON THE PROPERTY OF 3 THE EMPLOYER; TO LIMIT THE LIABILITY OF EMPLOYERS; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7 (2) of this section, a public or private employer may not establish, maintain, or enforce any policy or rule that has the 8 9 effect of prohibiting a person from transporting or storing a firearm in a locked vehicle in any parking lot, parking garage, or 10 other designated parking area. 11 (2) A private employer may prohibit an employee from 12 transporting or storing a firearm in a vehicle in a parking lot, 13 parking garage, or other parking area the employer provides for 14 employees if: 15 16 (a) The parking lot, garage, or other area is 17 completely surrounded by a gate and is not open to the public; and Ingress to and egress from the parking lot, garage, 18 (b) 19 or other area is monitored by security personnel. 20 (3) A public or private employer is not liable in a civil action for damages resulting from an occurrence involving the 21 transportation, storage or possession of a firearm under this 22 23 section. This section does not authorize a person to transport or 24 (4)store a firearm on any premises where the possession of a firearm 25 26 is prohibited by state or federal law. SECTION 2.
