HOUSE BILL NO. 1064

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-63-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REQUIRE THAT CONTRACT SELLERS OF PRE-NEED FUNERAL SERVICES AND 3 MERCHANDISE PLACE AT LEAST EIGHTY PERCENT OF THE FUNDS RECEIVED 4 FOR SUCH CONTRACTS FUNDED BY TRUST INTO A TRUST ACCOUNT IN A 5 FINANCIAL INSTITUTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 75-63-59, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 75-63-59. (1) If the contract is funded by trust, the 10 Secretary of State shall be given a copy of the trust document and 11 shall be informed in writing as to how the assets of the trust are 12 held. In the event of any change in the investments of the assets 13 of the trust, or change in the trustee or trust institution, the 14 Secretary of State shall be informed not less than thirty (30) 15 days after the time such change occurs.

16 (2) Any trustee, other than a financial institution, shall 17 not be the contract provider, the seller, or an officer or 18 director of the contract provider if the contract provider is a 19 corporation.

(3) Within twenty (20) days from the end of the month in 20 21 which the funds were received, the contract seller shall place in 22 a trust account in a financial institution as defined by this article at least eighty percent (80%) of the funds received. If 23 the contract seller places less than one hundred percent (100%) in 24 the trust account, the pre-need contract shall fully disclose to 25 the contract purchaser the amount deposited in trust and the 26 27 amount withheld by the contract seller.

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(4) Reasonable annual trust fees including any income taxes
owed to the State of Mississippi and/or the United States Treasury
may be withheld from the earnings of the trust.

31 (5) At the time of death, if the contract provider provides 32 the merchandise and services indicated in the contract, the 33 contract provider shall furnish to the trustee a copy of the buyer's death certificate or proof of death and a letter of 34 performance indicating that the contracted merchandise and 35 services were provided by the contract provider to the contract 36 insured. Upon receipt of the letter of performance and death 37 38 certificate, or proof of death, the trustee shall pay to the contract provider all funds. 39

40 (6) If the contract provider does not furnish merchandise
41 and services as provided in the pre-need contract, the trustee
42 shall pay to the estate of the contract insured or the substitute
43 provider not less than the amount deposited in trust, within ten
44 (10) days from notification of the death of the contract insured.
45 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
46 and after July 1, 2006.
