HOUSE BILL NO. 1102

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-125, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO REQUIRE THAT A QUALIFIED ELECTOR'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER BE
3 LISTED ON THE POLLBOOK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-125, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 23-15-125. The pollbook of each voting precinct shall have
8 printed or written at the top of each page words to designate the
9 voting precinct for which it is to be used, and shall be ruled in
10 appropriate columns, with printed or written headings, as follows:
11 date of registration; name of electors; date of birth; social
12 security number and a number of blank columns for the dates of
13 elections. All who register within thirty (30) days before any
14 regular election shall be entered on the pollbooks immediately
15 after such election, and not before, so that the pollbooks will
16 show only the names and social security numbers of those qualified
17 to vote at such election. When election commissioners determine
18 that any elector is disqualified from voting, by reason of removal
19 from the supervisor's district, or other cause, that fact shall be
20 noted on the registration book and his name shall be erased from
21 the pollbook.

22 **SECTION 2.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
23 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
24 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
25 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
26 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the

27 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
28 extended.

29 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
30 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
31 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
