- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 45-9-53, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 45-9-53. (1) This section and Section 45-9-51 do not affect
- 8 the authority that a county or municipality may have under another
- 9 law:
- (a) To require citizens or public employees to be armed 10
- for personal or national defense, law enforcement, or another 11
- 12 lawful purpose;
- 13 (b) To regulate the discharge of firearms within the
- limits of the county or municipality. A county or municipality 14
- 15 may not apply a regulation relating to the discharge of firearms
- 16 or other weapons in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the
- county or municipality or in an area annexed by the county or 17
- municipality after September 1, 1981, if the firearm or other 18
- 19 weapon is:
- 20 (i) A shotgun, air rifle or pistol, BB gun or bow
- 21 and arrow discharged:
- 22 1. On a tract of land of ten (10) acres or
- more and more than one hundred fifty (150) feet from a residence 23
- or occupied building located on another property; and 24
- 25 2. In a manner not reasonably expected to
- 26 cause a projectile to cross the boundary of the tract; or
