- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-7-33. (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild
- 8 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
- of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of 9
- calls of any kind, except a person: 10
- (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for 11
- 12 hunting coyote and crow;
- 13 May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and
- May use lures for trapping furbearing animals, 14
- 15 beaver, coyote, fox and nutria according to regulations adopted by
- the commission; and 16
- (d) May hunt deer with the aid of bait if the bait is 17
- 18 not within the hunter's immediate line of sight. Unless a person
- is openly and visibly hunting deer with the aid of bait within his 19
- 20 immediate line of sight, law enforcement officers of the
- 21 department may not issue a citation or fine any person.
- 22 The commission, in its discretion, may relax the
- restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a 23
- condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of 24
- Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or 25
- 26 livestock in a certain community, county or area.

27 (3) A person may use bait to trap wild hogs as defined in
28 Section 49-7-140 during the period between the end of Spring
29 turkey season and the beginning of deer season with bow and arrow.
30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
31 and after July 1, 2006.
