## HOUSE BILL NO. 1207

AN ACT TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE EFFECTIVENESS AND 1 EFFICIENCY OF THE STATE'S PROCEDURES TO DISPOSE OF STATE PROPERTY; 2 3 TO EVALUATE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND 4 ADMINISTRATION FOR PURPOSES OF REMOVING THE BUREAU OF BUILDINGS FROM ITS AUTHORITY; TO MAKE A REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON 5 6 TO THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. (1) There is created a task force to study the 9 effectiveness and efficiency of the state's procedures to dispose 10 of state property. The study shall also consist of an evaluation and assessment of the Mississippi Department of Finance and 11 Administration for the purpose of removing from under its 12 authority the Bureau of Buildings. The task force shall make a 13 report of its findings and recommendations, including any 14 recommended legislation to the Legislature by December 1, 2006. 15 (2) The task force shall be composed of the following ten 16 17 (10) members: 18 (a) Three (3) members of the Mississippi House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the Mississippi House 19 20 of Representatives; (b) Three (3) members of the Mississippi Senate 21 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Mississippi; 22 (c) Two (2) members appointed by the Governor of the 23 24 State of Mississippi; 25 The Executive Director of the Mississippi (d) Department of Finance and Administration; and 26 27 (e) The Director of the Bureau of Buildings. thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by the Speaker of the 30 31 House and the Lieutenant Governor, the task force shall meet and 32 organize by selecting from its membership a chairman and a vice 33 The vice chairman shall also serve as secretary and chairman. 34 shall be responsible for keeping all records of the task force. Α 35 majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a In the selection of its officers and the adoption of 36 quorum. rules, resolutions and reports, an affirmative vote of a majority 37 of the task force shall be required. All members shall be 38 notified in writing of all meetings, such notices to be mailed at 39 40 least fifteen (15) days before the date on which a meeting is to be held. 41

The task force shall study and make recommendations (4) 42 regarding potential legalization addressing the effectiveness and 43 efficiency of the state's procedures for disposing of state 44 property. It shall also be the duty of the task force to study 45 46 and make recommendations to the Legislature to remove the Bureau 47 of Buildings from the authority of the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration. The task force shall work and 48 49 coordinate with various state agencies to better effectuate the 50 study and to recommend viable solutions for more effective 51 policies and procedures to dispose of state property.

Members of the task force who are not legislators, state 52 (5) 53 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem 54 rate authorized by Section 25-3-69 and shall be reimbursed in accordance with Section 25-3-41 for mileage and actual expenses 55 56 incurred in the performance of their duties. Legislative members of the task force shall be paid from the contingent expense funds 57 of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for 58 committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session. 59 60 However, no per diem or expense for attending meetings of the task 61 force will be paid to legislative members of the task force while 62 the Legislature is in session. diem, travel or other expenses unless previously authorized by vote, at a meeting of the task force, which action shall be recorded in the official minutes of the meeting. Nonlegislative members shall be paid from any funds made available to the task force for that purpose.

The task force shall use clerical and legal staff 68 (6) already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance 69 70 made available to it. To effectuate the purposes of this section, any department, division, board, bureau, task force or agency of 71 the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the 72 73 request of the chairman of the task force, provide to the task 74 force such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the task 75 force properly to carry out its task.

76 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 77 and after its passage.
