AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 89-12-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 CLARIFY CERTAIN DEFINITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 89-12-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 89-12-3. As used in this act, unless the context otherwise 7 requires: 8 (a) "Banking organization" means any national or state 9 bank, trust company, savings bank, land bank, private banker, or any similar organization which is engaged in business in this 10 11 state. "Business association" means any corporation, joint 12 (b) stock company, business trust, partnership, or any association for 13 business purposes of two (2) or more individuals, whether 14 15 organized for profit or nonprofit, including, but not limited to, a banking organization, financial organization, life insurance 16 17 corporation and utility. "Financial organization" means any federal or state 18 (C) 19 savings and loan association, building and loan association, 20 credit union, cooperative bank or investment company, or any similar organization which is engaged in business in this state. 21 22 (d) "Holder" means any person in possession of property 23 subject to the provisions of this act belonging to another, or who is trustee in case of a trust, or is indebted to another on an 24 25 obligation subject to the provisions of this chapter. 26 (e) "Insurance corporation" means any association or 27 corporation transacting in this state the business of insurance *HR03/R1503SG* H. involving in any manner a person or property; however, this term 28 29 does not include self-insured workers' compensation groups or associations comprised of members who have joint and several 30 liability for the workers' compensation obligation of the other 31 32 members. 33 (f) "Intangible personal property" includes, but is not limited to: 34 (i) Monies, checks, drafts, deposits, interest, 35 dividends, and income; 36 (ii) Credit balances, customer overpayments, gift 37 38 certificates, security deposits, refunds, credit memos, unpaid wages, unused airline tickets, and unidentified remittances; 39 40 except future and prior dividends made by the workers' 41 compensation groups or associations described in paragraph (e); 42 (iii) Monies deposited to redeem stocks, bonds, coupons, and other securities, or to make distributions; 43 44 (iv) Amounts due and payable under the terms of 45 insurance policies; Amounts distributable from a trust or 46 (v) 47 custodial fund established under a plan to provide health, 48 welfare, pension, vacation, severance, retirement, death, stock 49 purchase, profit sharing, employee savings, supplemental unemployment insurance, or similar benefits; 50 (vi) Shares of corporate stock and other 51 52 intangible ownership interests in business associations; and (vii) Bonds, notes and other debt obligations. 53 54 (q) "Owner" means a depositor in case of a deposit, a 55 beneficiary in case of a trust, a creditor, claimant or payee in case of other choses in action, or any person having a legal or 56 equitable interest in property subject to the provisions of this 57 58 act, or his legal representative.

the records of the holder to be entitled to property held by the
holder.

(i) "Person" means any individual, business
association, government or political subdivision or agency,
corporation, public authority, estate, trust, two (2) or more
persons having a joint or common interest, or any other legal or
commercial entity whether such person is acting in his own right
or in a representative capacity.

68 (j) "Treasurer" means the State Treasurer of the State69 of Mississippi.

(k) "Utility" means any person who owns or operates in
this state for public use, any plant, equipment, property,
franchise, or license for the transmission of communications or
the production, storage, transmission, sale, delivery, or
furnishing of electricity, water, steam or gas.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
