HOUSE BILL NO. 1303

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-33-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO CLARIFY WHEN SEX OFFENDERS' NAMES CAN BE REMOVED FROM THE STATE 3 REGISTRY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 45-33-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 45-33-47. (1) A sex offender with a duty to register under
8 Section 45-33-25 shall only be relieved of the duty under
9 subsection (2) of this section.

10 (2) A person having a duty to register under Section 11 45-33-25 may petition the circuit court of the sentencing 12 jurisdiction to be relieved of that duty under the following 13 conditions:

The offender has maintained his registration in 14 (a) 15 Mississippi for not less than ten (10) years from the most recent 16 date of occurrence of at least one (1) of the following: release from prison, placement on parole, supervised release or probation. 17 18 Incarceration for any offense will restart the ten-year minimum registration requirement. Registration in any other jurisdiction 19 20 or state does not reduce the ten-year time requirement for 21 maintaining registration in Mississippi.

(b) If the offender has been convicted of one (1) of the following offenses, the offender is subject to lifetime registration and shall not be relieved of the duty to register:

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(i) Section 97-3-65 relating to rape;

26 (ii) Section 97-3-71 relating to rape and assault
27 with intent to ravish;

The court may relieve the offender of the duty to 62 register only if the petitioner shows, by clear and convincing 63 evidence, that the registrant properly maintained his registration 64 as required by law and that future registration of the petitioner 65 will not serve the purposes of this chapter.

(4) The offender will be required to continue registration
for any sex offense conviction unless the conviction is set aside
in any post-conviction proceeding <u>or</u> the offender receives a
pardon * * *. Upon submission of the appropriate documentation to
the department of one (1) of these occurrences, registration
duties will be discontinued.

72 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 73 and after July 1, 2006.
