HOUSE BILL NO. 1342

AN ACT TO REQUIRE PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN GRADES SEVEN 1 2 THROUGH TWELVE TO MAINTAIN A 2.0 CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY SCHOOL ATHLETIC 3 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Beginning with the 2006-2007 school year, in 6 7 order to be eligible to participate in any athletic program in a public school, a student in Grades 7 through 12 must maintain a 8 9 minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 calculated at the 10 end of each grading term, on a 4.0 scale. 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

12 and after July 1, 2006.
