- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** (1) In addition to the curriculum otherwise
- 5 required by law or the State Board of Education, beginning with
- 6 the 2007-2008 school year, an introduction to criminal law must be
- 7 taught as a one-semester course to all students in the public
- 8 elementary schools of this state. The course of study in criminal
- 9 law must be developmentally age appropriate and must be taught to
- 10 students before their completion of the fifth grade.
- 11 (2) The State Board of Education shall develop an
- 12 introductory course on criminal law, which shall be taught in the
- 13 public high schools of this state beginning with the 2007-2008
- 14 school year, and which shall be required for graduation from high
- 15 school for all students beginning in the 2009-2010 school year.
- 16 The course shall equal one-half (1/2) unit of high school course
- 17 work and may incorporate any appropriate existing secondary level
- 18 courses.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a
- 20 separate code section in Chapter 13, Title 37, Mississippi Code of
- 21 1972.
- 22 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2006.
