HOUSE BILL NO. 1355

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 CLARIFY THAT THE SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS 2 3 OF THE VARIOUS COUNTIES SHALL NOT BE REDUCED AS A RESULT OF A 4 REDUCTION IN TOTAL ASSESSED VALUATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 25-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 25-3-13. (1) The salaries of the members of the boards of 8 9 supervisors of the various counties are fixed as full compensation 10 for their services. The annual salary of each member of the board of supervisors 11 shall be based upon the total assessed valuation of his respective 12 13 county for the preceding taxable year in the following categories and for the following amounts: 14 (a) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 15 16 less than Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00), a salary of Twenty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000.00); 17 (b) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 18 19 at least Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00), but less than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), a salary of Thirty-two 20 Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$32,300.00); 21 (c) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 22 23 at least Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), but less than Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), a salary of 24 Thirty-three Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$33,700.00); 25 26 (d) For counties having a total assessed valuation of at least Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), but less 27

28 than One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), a 29 salary of Thirty-four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$34,700.00); 30 (e) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 31 at least One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars 32 (\$125,000,000.00), but less than Three Hundred Million Dollars 33 (\$300,000,000.00), a salary of Forty Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$40,400.00); 34 For counties having a total assessed valuation of 35 (f) at least Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), but less 36 than One Billion Dollars (\$1,000,000,000.00), a salary of 37 38 Forty-four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$44,700.00); For counties having a total assessed valuation of 39 (g) 40 One Billion Dollars (\$1,000,000,000.00), but less than Two Billion Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00), a salary of Forty-five Thousand Seven 41 Hundred Dollars (\$45,700.00); 42 For counties having a total assessed valuation of 43 (h) Two Billion Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) or more, a salary of 44 Forty-six Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$46,700.00). 45 The salary of the members of the board of supervisors shall 46 47 not be increased under this section until the board of supervisors 48 shall have passed a resolution stating the amount of the increase 49 and spread it on its minutes. (2) The annual salary established for board of supervisors 50 shall not be reduced as a result of a reduction in total assessed 51 valuation. The salaries shall be increased as a result of an 52 53 increase in total assessed valuation. 54 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 55 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 56 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 57 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 58 59 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 60 extended.
