HOUSE BILL NO. 1367

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF RED CREEK IN STONE,
2 GEORGE AND JACKSON COUNTIES AS A STATE SCENIC STREAM AND TO
3 INCLUDE THE STREAM IN THE STATE SCENIC STREAMS STEWARDSHIP
4 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** In accordance with Section 51-4-7, Red Creek from
7 Mississippi Highway 26 in Stone County to its confluence with
8 Black Creek in Jackson County, which was designated as eligible
9 for nomination to the State Scenic Streams Stewardship Program
10 under Section 51-4-21.5, is designated as a state scenic stream
11 and is included in the State Scenic Streams Stewardship Program.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
13 and after its passage.
