HOUSE BILL NO. 1454

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT GATHERING PERSONAL INFORMATION OF LAW
2 ENFORCEMENT, JUDICIAL AND PROSECUTORIAL PERSONNEL; TO PROVIDE
3 PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** It shall be unlawful to gather information
6 regarding the identity, address, any telephone number or others
7 private information of any law enforcement officer, criminal
8 investigator, judge or district attorney or the spouse or child of
9 such law enforcement officer, criminal investigator, judge or
10 district attorney. Any person who violates the provisions of this
11 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction,
12 shall be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
14 and after July 1, 2006.
