L2	SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be

100	SECTION 6. The Legislature shall have the authority to
101	escalate its budget and expend funds from the Legislative
102	Extraordinary Session Expense Revolving Fund, as authorized in

104	and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in
105	a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. The
106	authority granted in this section is provided for the purpose of
