5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

8	Defense Counsel of the State of Mississippi for the purpose of		
9	defraying the expenses of the office for the fiscal year beginning

58	SECTION 5 . It	is the intention of the Legis	slature that	
59	whenever two (2) or 1	more bids are received by thi	s agency for the	
60	purchase of commodit	hase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things		
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- 61 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 62 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 63 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 64 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 65 made without competitive bids.
- 66 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 67 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 68 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 70 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 71 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 72 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 73 and after July 1, 2006.
