## HOUSE BILL NO. 1560

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI AUTHORITY FOR EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Authority for
9	Educational Television for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006,
10	and ending June 30, 2007\$ 5,054,532.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
14	Authority for Educational Television which is comprised of special
15	source funds collected by or otherwise available to the Authority,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the
17	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
18	\$ 4,499,948.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

43	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
44	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
45	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
46	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
47	July 1, 2006.
48	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
49	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
50	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
51	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
52	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
53	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
54	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
55	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
56	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
57	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
58	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
59	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
60	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal

- 61 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 62 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 63 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 64 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 65 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 66 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 67 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 68 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 69 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 72 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 73 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 74 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 75 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 76 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 77 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 78 appropriated level.
- 79 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 80 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 81 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 82 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the
- 84 continuation of a full and complete broadcast schedule of
- 85 educational and instructional, professional growth, and public
- 86 service programs, with the production of new films and programs to
- 87 be secondary thereto.
- 88 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 89 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall maintain
- 90 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 91 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 92 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 93 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of

- 94 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 95 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 96 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 97 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request
- 98 process.
- 99 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 100 Section 2, One Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Sixty-seven
- 101 Dollars (\$1,644,067.00) shall be derived from the Education
- 102 Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
- 103 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 104 SECTION 6. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be
- 105 transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for
- 106 the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication
- 107 activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor
- 108 shall any personnel paid or equipment purchased with funds
- 109 appropriated hereby be transferred or assigned to any other state
- 110 agency, department or officer for public relations, publicity or
- 111 publication activities of such office.
- 112 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 113 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the
- 114 authority to expend funds in the Capital Equipment Replacement
- 115 Revolving Fund, in accordance with Section 37-63-17, Mississippi
- 116 Code of 1972, for the purpose of purchasing technical equipment
- 117 for operating the educational radio and television facilities.
- 118 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 119 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the
- 120 authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source
- 121 not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance
- 122 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 123 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 124 federal funds.
- 125 **SECTION 9.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 126 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

127	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
128	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
129	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
130	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
131	performance measures provided below:

149	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
150	Executive Director of the Mississippi Authority for Educational
151	Television may increase major objects of expenditure in total
152	amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the
153	appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided
154	that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
155	corresponding dollar amount and provided the Executive Director of
156	the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration also
157	approves with written authorization. However, no transfers shall
158	be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
159	"Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

160	<b>SECTION 11.</b> It is the intention of the Legislature that
161	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
162	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
163	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
164	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
165	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
166	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
167	made without competitive bids.
168	SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
169	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
170	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
171	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
172	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
173	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
174	SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from

175 and after July 1, 2006.
