1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying
9	out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972,
10	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
11	June 30, 2007\$ 10,873,609.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
15	Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds
16	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
17	purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal
18	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
19	\$ 2,819,711.00.
20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
22	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
23	expenditure:

44	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
45	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
46	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
47	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
48	July 1, 2006.
49	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
50	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
51	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
52	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
53	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
54	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
55	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
56	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
57	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
58	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
59	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
60	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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- 61 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 62 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 63 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 64 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 65 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 66 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 67 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 68 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 69 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 70 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 71 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 72 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 73 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 74 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 75 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 76 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 77 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 78 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 79 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 81 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 82 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 83 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems
- 85 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid
- 86 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March
- 87 31 and June 30.
- 88 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 89 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting
- 90 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 91 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 92 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 93 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

94	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
95	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
96	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
97	during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
98	SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
99	Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred
100	Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the
101	Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
102	and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
103	SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
104	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
105	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
106	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
107	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
108	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
109	performance measures provided below:

- 126 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
- 127 Committee for Fiscal Year 2008.
- 128 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 129 Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to
- 130 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed
- 131 Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and
- 132 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 133 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 134 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than
- 135 One Million Eighty-six Thousand Three Hundred Forty Dollars
- 136 (\$1,086,340.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database.
- 137 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 138 Executive Director of the Mississippi Library Commission may
- 139 increase major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to
- 140 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of
- 141 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major
- 142 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar
- 143 amount and provided the Executive Director of the Mississippi
- 144 Department of Finance and Administration also approves with
- 145 written authorization. However, no transfers shall be authorized
- 146 which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages
- 147 and Fringe Benefits."
- 148 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two
- 149 Million Nine Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Eighty
- 150 Dollars (\$2,957,280.00) is provided for the cost of health
- 151 insurance for all full-time library staff members in each public
- 152 library in Mississippi.
- 153 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 154 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 155 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 156 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 157 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 158 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.

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
