HOUSE BILL NO. 1564

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2 3 2007. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 9 30,204,756.00. .....\$ 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by 14 15 or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year 16 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 17 18 .....\$ 229,904,210.00. 19 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 20 Section 2, Nine Million Eight Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand Five 21 Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$9,859,513.00) shall be derived from the 22 Health Care Expendable Fund, created in Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the 23 State Department of Health. The funds provided in this section 24 shall be allocated as follows: 25 26 Maternal and Child Health Care Program.....\$ 975,499.00 27

33 The State Department of Health may transfer a portion of 34 Trauma Care System funds to the Division of Medicaid for the 35 development and implementation of an enhanced reimbursement fee 36 program related to trauma care and services, used to match federal 37 funds, under a cooperative agreement between the State Department 38 of Health and the Division of Medicaid.

It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the Four 39 40 Million One Hundred Eighty Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$4,180,713.00) authorized herein for the Trauma Care System shall 41 be expended to the benefit of any hospital located outside the 42 boundaries of the State of Mississippi, unless otherwise excepted 43 in this paragraph. Further, unless otherwise excepted in this 44 45 paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be authorized to receive such funds until such time as the amount appropriated for 46 such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight Million Dollars 47 (\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended by the 48 49 Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the Regional 50 Medical Center at Memphis, located in Memphis, Tennessee, for 51 their participation in the Trauma Care System.

52 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 53 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 54 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 55 expenditure:

For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on July 1, 2006.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 81 82 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 83 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 84 85 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 86 87 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 88 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 89 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 90 91 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 92 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 93 \*HR05/A301\* H. Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 94 95 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 96 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 97 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 98 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 99 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 100 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 101 102 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

103 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 104 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 105 106 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 107 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 108 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 109 110 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 111 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 116 117 State Department of Health shall maintain complete accounting and 118 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 119 120 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 121 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 122 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 123 124 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 125 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

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SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 126 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 127 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 128 129 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 130 intended mission of this agency. SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 168 169 Mississippi Department of Health shall have authority to escalate the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval 170 171 of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds collected or 172 available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year, not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), to the agency 173 174 for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Mississippi Department 175 of Health may expend such funds in the manner authorized by law.

176 The Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Health shall submit to the Department of Finance and 177 178 Administration a certified statement providing a detailed explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the 179 180 establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing 181 positions and the existence of any required matching funds for those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's 182 183 General Fund Budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the 184 fiscal year in which the escalation is requested.

185 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with 186 the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may 187 provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to 188 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such 189 vaccinations through job related exposure.

190 SECTION 9. In addition to all other sums heretofore
191 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
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192 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 193 Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural 194 195 Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in 196 Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for 197 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year 198 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 199 200 28,000,000.00. .....\$

201 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 202 Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of 203 Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate 204 special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. These 205 funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no 206 later than July 31, 2006. The State Department of Health shall 207 make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the 208 Department of Human Services.

209 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty 210 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section 211 212 1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as 213 "Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents 214 215 over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder 216 adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the 217 cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed 218 pathology and biannual MRI exams.

SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as authorized in the case <u>Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State</u> <u>of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery</u>

appropriated in this section, an amount not less than Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund the School Tobacco Nurse Program.

SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) are provided for the purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and other necessary AIDS related medical services.

SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, 236 237 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be provided to the Southern AIDS Commission, Inc., for the purpose of providing 238 technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education 239 240 on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery services to persons infected with HIV. The Southern AIDS 241 242 Commission, Inc. shall report by February 1, 2007, to the Board of Health and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health 243 244 Committees the status of the project and all services provided.

SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 3, the amounts of One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the T.K. Martin Center at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the Regional Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention Program.

252 **SECTION 16.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand 253 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Breast and Cervical 254 Cancer Program.

SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the State Department of Health may authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to H. B. No. 1564 \*HR05/A301\* 06/HR05/A301 PAGE 8 (RM\ST) exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

264 SECTION 18. In addition to all other funds heretofore appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 265 266 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 267 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Burn Care Fund which is 268 comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of funding the 269 270 development of a plan for delivery of services and of providing 271 reimbursement for uncompensated medical care to Mississippi burn victims through the trauma care system, for the fiscal year 272 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 273 274 .....\$3,000,000.00.

275 SECTION 19. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be provided to the North 276 277 Mississippi Prevention Center, for the purpose of providing technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education 278 279 on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery 280 services to persons infected with HIV. The North Mississippi Prevention Center, shall report by February 1, 2007, to the Board 281 282 of Health and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health Committees the status of the project and all services provided. 283

SECTION 20. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

292 SECTION 21. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 293 294 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 295 296 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 297 SECTION 22. This act shall take effect and be in force from 298 and after July 1, 2006. 299
