4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
10	\$ 32,664,735.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department
14	of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by
15	or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
18	\$ 237,803,382.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Sections 1 and 2, Two Million Seven Hundred Three Thousand
21	Ninety-four Dollars (\$2,703,094.00) shall be derived from the
22	State General Fund and Nine Million Eight Hundred Fifty-nine
23	Thousand Five Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$9,859,513.00) shall be
24	derived from the Health Care Expendable Fund, created in Section
25	43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and
26	maintenance of the State Department of Health. The funds provided

171	SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
172	Mississippi Department of Health shall have authority to escalate
173	the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval
174	of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds collected or
175	available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year,
176	not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), to the agency
177	for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Mississippi Department
178	of Health may expend such funds in the manner authorized by law.
179	The Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of
180	Health shall submit to the Department of Finance and
181	Administration a certified statement providing a detailed
182	explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the
183	establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing
184	positions and the existence of any required matching funds for
185	those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's
186	General Fund Budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the
187	fiscal year in which the escalation is requested.
188	SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that with
189	the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may
190	provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to
191	Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such
192	vaccinations through job related exposure.
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193	SECTION 9. In addition to all other sums heretofore
194	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
195	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
196	Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water
197	Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural
198	Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in
199	Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for
200	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and
201	Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year
202	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
203	\$ 28,000,000.00.
204	SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
205	Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of
206	Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate
207	special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. These
208	funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no
209	later than July 31, 2006. The State Department of Health shall
210	make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the
211	Department of Human Services.
212	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
213	State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty
214	Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section
215	1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as
216	"Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder
217	adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents
218	over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder
219	adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the
220	cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed
221	pathology and biannual MRI exams.
222	SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore
223	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
224	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in

- It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds

- 234 the School Tobacco Nurse Program.
- 235 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven
- 236 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) are provided for the
- 237 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and other necessary AIDS related
- 238 medical services.
- 239 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1,
- 240 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be provided to the
- 241 Southern AIDS Commission, Inc., for the purpose of providing
- 242 technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education
- 243 on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery
- 244 services to persons infected with HIV. The Southern AIDS
- 245 Commission, Inc. shall report by February 1, 2007, to the Board of
- 246 Health and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health

- 248 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 249 and allocated in Section 3, the amounts of One Hundred Ten
- 250 Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be
- 251 allocated to the T.K. Martin Center at Mississippi State
- 252 University and One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven
- 253 Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the Regional
- 254 Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention
- 255 Program.
- 256 **SECTION 16.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand
- 257 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Breast and Cervical
- 258 Cancer Program.

SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 259 260 Executive Director of the State Department of Health may authorize 261 increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 262 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 263 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 264 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 265 amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe 266 267 Benefits." SECTION 18. In addition to all other funds heretofore 268 269 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 270 271 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Burn Care Fund which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise 272 available to the department, for the purpose of funding the 273 274 development of a plan for delivery of services and of providing 275 reimbursement for uncompensated medical care to Mississippi burn 276 victims through the trauma care system, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007...... 277 278 .....\$3,000,000.00. The State Department of Health shall issue any certificates 279 280 of need necessary to any person proposing the construction of, 281 addition of, or conversion of any beds or the expansion of any health care facility for use exclusively for the treatment of burn 282 283 victims, and such beds shall be classified and limited to use for 284 such treatment of burn victims and may not be converted to any 285 other use and are not to be classified or included in the acute care bed inventory of the state for health planning purposes. 286 Any 287 such beds shall participate in the statewide trauma care system as 288 provided by Section 41-59-5 and be entitled to an allocation of 289 funds from the Mississippi Burn Care Fund as established by 290 Section 7-9-70. For purposes of this subsection, the provisions 291 of Section 41-7-193(1) requiring substantial compliance with the \*HR03/A301SG\* H. B. No. 1564

06/HR03/A301SG PAGE 9 (RM\ST\LH) 293 are waived. SECTION 19. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, 294 295 Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be provided to the 296 North Mississippi Prevention Center, for the purpose of providing 297 technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery 298 services to persons infected with HIV. The North Mississippi 299 300 Prevention Center, shall report by February 1, 2007, to the Board of Health and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health 301 302 Committees the status of the project and all services provided. SECTION 20. It is the intention of the Legislature that 303 304 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 305 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 306 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 307 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 308 309 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 310 311 SECTION 21. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 312 313 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 314 315 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 316 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 22. This act shall take effect and be in force from 317 318 and after July 1, 2006.
