HOUSE BILL NO. 1566

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2. STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2007. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters 8 9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board 10 of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 11 33,300.00. SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 12 State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete 13 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 14 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 15 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 16 17 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 18 19 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 20 21 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that 22 23 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 24 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 25 26 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 27

- 28 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 29 made without competitive bids.
- 30 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 31 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 32 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 33 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 34 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 35 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 36 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 2006.
