HOUSE BILL NO. 1568

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE 2 3 FISCAL YEAR 2007; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 8 defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 9 7,964,339.00. June 30, 2007..... \$ 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 14 15 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 16 year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 17 18 \$ 3,355,648.00. 19 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on July 1, 2006.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 48 49 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 50 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 51 52 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 53 54 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 55 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 56 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 57 58 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 59 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 60 *HR05/A475* H. Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 61 62 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 63 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 64 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 65 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 66 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 67 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 68 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 69

70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 72 73 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 74 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 75 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 76 77 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 78 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 83 84 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete 85 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 86 87 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 88 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 89 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 90 91 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 92 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

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93 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 94 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 95 96 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 97 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 98 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 99 100 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

101 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 102 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 103 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 104 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 105 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 106 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 107 Archives and History.

108 **SECTION 7.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 109 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 110 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 111 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

112 SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 113 114 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local 115 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost 116 of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and 117 ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 78,983.00. Of the funds appropriated in this section, not more than the 118 119 amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major

The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 170 171 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 172 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 173

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 9. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

183 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept, 184 185 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to 186 187 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section 188 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of 189 paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, the 190 Old Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, and the War Memorial 191 Building, in accordance with rules and regulations of the *HR05/A475* H. B. No. 1568 06/HR05/A475

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192 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 193 with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 11. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 199 200 Executive Director of the Department of Archives and History may 201 authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total 202 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 203 204 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 205 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 206 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 207 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

208 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that 209 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 210 211 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 212 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 213 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 214 215 made without competitive bids.

216 SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 217 218 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 219 220 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 221 222 SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from 223 and after July 1, 2006.

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
