AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE GRAND GULF MILITARY MONUMENT COMMISSION FOR 2 THE FISCAL YEAR 2007. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 8 defraying the expenses of the Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission in the operation and maintenance of the Grand Gulf 9 Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and 10 ending June 30, 2007.....\$ 238,764.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Grand Gulf 14 15 Military Monument Commission, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission in the operation and maintenance of the 16 Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning 17 18 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 89,793.00. 19 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 20 Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 21 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 22 Permanent: Full Time..... 7 Part Time..... 23 2 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 24 0 Part Time..... 25 0 26 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 27

32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 47 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 56 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 57 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 67 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete 68 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 69 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 70 71 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 72 73 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 74 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 75 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 76

SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that 86 87 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 88 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 89 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 90 91 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 92 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 93

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94 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 95 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 96 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 97 98 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 99 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 100 and after July 1, 2006. 101
