Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, with not more than one-half (1/2) to be awarded on July 1, 2006, with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.

38 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 39 40 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 43 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 45 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 49 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 50 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 51 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 52 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 53 54 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 55 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 56 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 57 58 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 59 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

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Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 60 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 63 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 65 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 67 appropriated level. 68

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 73 74 Pat Harrison Waterway District shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 75 76 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 77 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 78 2006 79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 82

83 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 84 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 85 86 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 87 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 88 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 89 90 made without competitive bids.

91 SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except 92 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which H. B. No. 1585 \*HRO3/A480SG\* 06/HR03/A480SG

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93 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, 94 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the 95 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent 96 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills 97 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

98 **SECTION 6.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 99 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 100 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
