4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI	:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State	
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial	
8	Stadium Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the	
9	Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for the fiscal	
10	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007	
11	\$ 1,416,719.00	•
12	In addition to the funds appropriated herein, the Mississipp	i
13	Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission is hereby authorized to	
14	disburse to participating institutions, agencies or departments	
15	their shares or divisions of gate receipts.	
16	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of	f
17	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be

40	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
41	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
42	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
43	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
44	July 1, 2006.
45	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
46	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
47	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
48	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
49	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
50	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
51	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
52	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
53	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
54	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
55	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
56	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
57	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
58	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
59	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
60	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
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- 61 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 62 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 63 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 64 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 65 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 66 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 69 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 70 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 71 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 72 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 73 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 74 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 75 appropriated level.
- 76 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 77 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 78 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 80 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 81 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall maintain
- 82 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 83 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 84 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 85 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of
- 86 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 87 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 88 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 89 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request
- 90 process.
- 91 **SECTION 4**. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 92 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 93 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 94 95 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 96 97 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 98 made without competitive bids. SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 99 100 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 101 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 102 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 103 104 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 105 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2006.
