4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:			
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out			
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available			
8	to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the purpose			
9	of defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year			
10	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007			
11	\$ 15,111,211.00.			
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of			
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be			
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of			
15	expenditure:

32	For the fiscal	year beginning on July 1,	2006, funds are	
33	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee			
34	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an			
35	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on			
36	July 1, 2006.			
37	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of			
38	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			
39	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal			
40	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007			
41	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions			
42	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the			
43	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the			
44	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall			
45	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all			
46	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this			
47	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure			
48	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual			
49	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal			
50	Services" when annua	alized, with the exception	of escalated funds.	
51	If, at the time the	agency takes any action to	change "Personal	
52	Services," the State	e Personnel Board determine	s that the agency	
53	has taken an action	which would cause the agen	cy to exceed this	
54	projected annual co	st or the Fiscal Year 2007	"Personal Services"	
55	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which			
56	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation			
57	requirement will be	processed by the State Per	sonnel Board until

59	Any transfers	or escalations shall be mad	e in accordance with

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    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
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    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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    approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
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    without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
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    appropriated level.
         No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
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    used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
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    being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
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    act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
         With the funds herein appropriated, funds are included and
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    authorized in the Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits major object
    of expenditure to pay "call back pay" in lieu of "compensatory
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    time credit," at the discretion of the Director of the Pearl River
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    Valley Water Supply District, to any employee who must work on a
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    statutory holiday or any holiday proclaimed by the Governor.
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         SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
    Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete
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    accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
    funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
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    in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
    Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
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    the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be
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    submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
    and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
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    provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
         SECTION 4.
                     It is the intention of the Legislature that
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    whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
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purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

- 95 made without competitive bids.
- 96 **SECTION 5.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
- 97 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
- 98 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
- 99 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
- 100 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent
- 101 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
- 102 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 103 **SECTION 6.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
- 104 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
- 105 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with
- 106 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.
- 107 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 108 and after July 1, 2006.
