HOUSE BILL NO. 1592

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE TOMBIGBEE RIVER VALLEY 2 3 WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available 8 to the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, for the purpose of paying bond maturities, accrued interest, maintenance 9 expenses, project development costs, and any other authorized 10 expenses of the water management district, for the fiscal year 11 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 12 13\$ 3,949,392.00. SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 14 15 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 16 17 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 18 19 Personal Services: 20 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 778,692.00 21 Travel and Subsistence..... 62,000.00 22 Contractual Services..... 480,000.00 210,000.00 Commodities..... 23 Capital Outlay: 24 Other Than Equipment..... 1,788,000.00 25 26 Equipment..... 590,700.00 27 Subsidies, Loans and Grants..... 40,000.00

No. 1592 *HR05/A488* 06/HR05/A488 PAGE 1 (RM\ST) For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on July 1, 2006.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 39 40 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 42 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 43 44 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 48 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 49 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 51 52 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 53 54 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 55 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 56 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 57 58 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 59 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 60 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

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Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 63 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 64 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 65 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 66 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 67 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 68 appropriated level. 69

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

74 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain 76 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 77 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 78 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 79 80 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 81 82 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 83 84 process.

85 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 86 87 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 88 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 89 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 90 91 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 92 made without competitive bids.

94 excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank
95 or banks selected by the board of directors of the district.
96 These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such
97 manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest
98 earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.

99 SECTION 6. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 100 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 101 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
