HOUSE BILL NO. 1596

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF BARBER 2 3 EXAMINERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Barber Examiners, for 7 8 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 9 10\$ 218,884.00. SECTION 2. With the funds approved for expenditure under 11 12 Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 13 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Full Time..... 14 Permanent: 2 15 Part Time..... 4 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 16 0 Part Time..... 17 0 18 For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are 19 provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee 20 who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an 21 amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on 22 July 1, 2006. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 23 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 24 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 25 26 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 27

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are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 28 29 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 30 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 31 32 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 33 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 34 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 35 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 36 37 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 38 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 39 40 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 41 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 42 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 43 44 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 45 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 46

47 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 48 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 49 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 50 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 51 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 52 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 53 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

58 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 59 State Board of Barber Examiners shall maintain complete accounting 60 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds H. B. No. 1596 *HR05/A840. 1*

H. B. No. 1596 06/HR05/A840.1 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 68 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 69 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 70 71 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 72 73 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 74 75 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

82 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 83 and after July 1, 2006.
