HOUSE BILL NO. 1600

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI AUCTIONEERS COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Auctioneers Commission
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission, for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.
10	\$ 100,193.00.
11	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
12	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time 1
15	Part Time 0
16	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
17	Part Time 0
18	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
19	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
20	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
21	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
22	July 1, 2006.
23	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
24	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
25	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
26	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
27	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions

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28 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
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- 29 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 30 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 31 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 32 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 33 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 34 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 35 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 36 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 37 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 38 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 39 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 40 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 41 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 42 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 43 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 44 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 46 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 47 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 48 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 49 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 50 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 51 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 52 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 53 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 55 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 56 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 57 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- Of the above funds, none may be expended by this act to
- 59 provide for any regulatory authority over livestock auctioneers
- 60 conducting sales for an individual of his own property.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 61 62 Mississippi Auctioneers Commission shall maintain complete 63 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 64 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 65 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 66 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 67 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 68 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 69 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 70 71 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 72 73 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 74 75 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 76 77 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 78 made without competitive bids. SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 79 80 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 81 82 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 83 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 84 85 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2006.

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
