6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
8	Treasury to the credit of the Real Estate Appraisal License Fund,		
9	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Real		
10	Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board for the fiscal		
11	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 73
- 74 Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification
- 75 Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
- 76 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
- act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 77
- detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the 78
- 79 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
- Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 80
- 81 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 82 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007
- 83 budget request process.
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 84
- 85 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 86 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 87
- 88 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 89 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 90
- made without competitive bids. 91
- 92 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 93 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 94

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- 95 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 96 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 97 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 98 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 99 and after July 1, 2006.
