## HOUSE BILL NO. 1692

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MADISON 2 COUNTY TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PREPARATION OF 3 THE COUNTY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR DEVELOPMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY SERVICES SO PROVIDED UNDER CONTRACT SHALL BE CONSIDERED 4 SUPPLEMENTARY TO ANY SIMILAR SERVICES PROVIDED BY A LOCAL PLANNING 5 6 COMMISSION; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD TO CONTRACT FOR SUCH 7 SUPPLEMENTARY SERVICES WITH ANY PERSON WHO IS A MEMBER OF AN 8 EXISTING PLANNING COMMISSION AND PAY THE PERSON A FEE FOR SUCH SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Board of Supervisors of Madison County
- 12 may contract for any services associated with the preparation,
- 13 adoption, amendment, extension and carrying out of a comprehensive
- 14 plan for the purpose of bringing about coordinated development in
- 15 accordance with present and future needs of the county, as
- 16 described in Section 17-1-11, Mississippi Code of 1972. The board
- 17 is authorized to include, as a part of the execution of such a
- 18 contract, any aspects of the preparation of the following: (a) a
- 19 comprehensive plan of physical development of the municipality or
- 20 county; (b) a proposed zoning ordinance and map; (c) regulations
- 21 governing subdivisions of land; (d) building or set back lines on
- 22 streets, roads and highways; and (e) recommendations to the board
- 23 with regard to the enforcement of and amendments to the
- 24 comprehensive plan, zoning ordinance, subdivision regulations and
- 25 capital improvements program.
- 26 (2) If the board has created, independently or jointly, a
- 27 local planning commission to prepare and propose a comprehensive
- 28 plan, the services contracted for under the authority of
- 29 subsection (1) of this section shall be considered supplementary
- 30 to services provided by the commission to the board. The board

- 31 may contract for such supplementary services with any person who
- 32 is a member of an existing planning commission created under
- 33 Section 17-1-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, and it may pay the
- 34 person a contractual fee in addition to any amounts which he or
- 35 she may otherwise be authorized to receive under Section 17-1-11,
- 36 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after its passage.
