HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 14

- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO AMEND THE MISSISSIPPI
- 2 CONSTITUTION OF 1890 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION ESTABLISHING THE
- 3 RIGHT TO HUNT, FISH AND TRAP WILDLIFE AND FISH AS A CONSTITUTIONAL
- 4 RIGHT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 6 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 7 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 8 state:
- 9 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by adding a new
- 10 section to read as follows:
- "Section ____. (1) Hunting, trapping and fishing and the
- 12 taking of wild animals, birds and fish are a valued part of our
- 13 state's heritage and shall be preserved forever for the people.
- 14 Fish and wildlife management, including taking, is consistent with
- 15 the state's duty to protect this heritage and to conserve wild
- 16 animals, birds and fish.
- 17 (2) Fish and wildlife shall be managed by laws and
- 18 regulations that provide persons with the continued opportunity to
- 19 take, by traditional means and methods, species traditionally
- 20 pursued by hunters, anglers and trappers.
- 21 (3) Hunting, fishing or trapping by sportsmen shall always
- 22 be a preferred and available means of controlling all invasive or
- 23 overpopulated species.
- 24 (4) Any person who is licensed to hunt, fish or trap and who
- 25 is adversely affected by a failure to comply with this section has
- 26 a private cause of action to enforce this section.

- (5) The right of the people to hunt, fish, trap and harvest game is subject only to such regulations and restrictions as the Legislature may prescribe by general law.
- 30 (6) It is the public policy of the state to promote the 31 public and private acquisition, approval, construction and 32 operation of shooting ranges and other facilities where persons 33 may acquire and enhance their training and skills to hunt and 34 harvest game safely, efficiently and humanely."
- 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be 36 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at 37 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday 38 of November 2006, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution 39 and by general law.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed constitutional amendment establishes hunting, trapping and fishing and the taking of wild animals, birds and fish as a constitutional right subject only to such regulations and restrictions as the Legislature may prescribe by general law. The amendment also promotes as state public policy the acquisition and operation of public and private shooting ranges and other facilities to enhance the training and skills of persons to hunt and harvest game."
