HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 66

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MRS.  
2 JODI HARRIS FOR BEING SELECTED AS INSTRUCTOR OF THE YEAR AT THE  
3 JACKSON COUNTY CAMPUS OF THE MISSISSIPPI GULF COAST COMMUNITY  
4 COLLEGE.

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jodi Harris, a resident of Ocean Springs,  
6 Mississippi, has been selected as Instructor of the Year at the  
7 Jackson County Campus of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community  
8 College in recognition of her distinguished service to the  
9 college; and

10 WHEREAS, the award was established by the Alumni Association  
11 of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College to honor  
12 instructors at the college, and the recipient of the award is  
13 chosen from nominations submitted by students, faculty and  
14 administrators on the basis of their teaching excellence, college  
15 service, community service and professional development; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jodi Harris, a Business and Office Technology  
17 and Database Administration Technology instructor, has been  
18 employed at the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College for the  
19 past five years and has taught for the past seven years; and

20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jodi Harris received her Associate of Applied  
21 Science from Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College; her  
22 Bachelor of Science from the University of Southern Mississippi,  
23 and her Master of Science from the University of Southern  
24 Mississippi; and

25 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jodi Harris has served as the National Science  
26 Foundation Project director; completed the MGCCC Master Teacher  
27 Program; serves as the Phi Beta Lambda advisor; developed  
28 curriculum and implemented the only Database Administration

29 program in Mississippi community colleges and hosted the Women's  
30 Conference on Information Technology; and

31 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jodi Harris is a volunteer for the YMCA;  
32 cheerleader coach for the Upward Basketball League and assistant  
33 Youth Minister at Emmanuel Baptist Church; and

34 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jodi Harris was selected as a National Science  
35 Foundation grant applications reader; presenter at the League of  
36 Innovations CIT Conference; and

37 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize  
38 and commend such outstanding teachers as Mrs. Jodi Harris, who has  
39 dedicated her career to teaching the young people of this state:
