HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 74

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED
 2 STATES TO FURTHER REVIEW CONTRACTS AWARDING THE MANAGEMENT OF
 3 UNITED STATES PORTS AND HARBORS TO BUSINESSES OWNED BY FOREIGN
 4 GOVERNMENTS.

5 WHEREAS, the sale of management rights of our nation's ports
 6 and harbors to companies owned by foreign governments that have
 7 shown a lack of support towards the United States and its allies
 8 may be detrimental to our national security and free and
 9 unrestricted trade with our allies:

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
 11 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
 12 THEREIN, That we do hereby urge the President of the United States
 13 to further review contracts awarding the management of our
 14 nation's ports and harbors to companies owned in whole or in part
 15 by foreign governments.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
 17 furnished to the President of the United States, and to members of
 18 the Capitol Press Corps.
