HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 76

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE INTRODUCTION,
3 CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND
4 SECTION 29-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT EXPRESS
5 APPROVAL OF THE LEGISLATURE IS REQUIRED BEFORE THE LEASE, SALE OR
6 OTHER CONVEYANCE BY A STATE PORT AUTHORITY TO A PUBLIC ENTITY OF
7 SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY ASSOCIATED WITH THE STATE
8 PORT OR HARBOR OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY; TO AMEND SECTION
9 29-1-75, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN
10 NONRESIDENT ALIENS AND LEGAL ENTITIES CONTROLLED BY NONRESIDENT
11 ALIENS MAY NOT ACQUIRE OR HOLD ANY REAL PROPERTY OR ANY FACILITY,
12 STRUCTURE, OR OTHER IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATED WITH A STATE PORT OR
13 HARBOR; TO CREATE AN EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN NONRESIDENT ALIENS OR
14 LEGAL ENTITIES CONTROLLED BY NONRESIDENT ALIENS WHO OWN PROPERTY
15 THAT IS A PART OF OR ASSOCIATED WITH A STATE PORT OR HARBOR ON
16 DECEMBER 31, 2005; TO AMEND SECTION 59-5-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
17 1972, TO CLARIFY THAT EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE LEGISLATURE IS
18 REQUIRED BEFORE THE LEASE, SALE OR OTHER CONVEYANCE BY A STATE
19 PORT AUTHORITY TO A PUBLIC ENTITY OF SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED REAL
20 PROPERTY ASSOCIATED WITH A STATE PORT OR HARBOR THAT IS OPERATED
21 BY THE AUTHORITY; TO AMEND SECTIONS 59-5-1, 59-5-21, 59-5-23,
22 59-5-35, 59-5-37 AND 59-5-39, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN
23 CONFORMITY THERETO AND TO CLARIFY THE POWERS OF THE STATE PORT
24 AUTHORITY; TO PROHIBIT A MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY OR OTHER POLITICAL
25 SUBDIVISION FROM IMPOSING CERTAIN IMPACT FEES ON PROPERTY OWNED BY
26 THE STATE THAT IS ASSOCIATED WITH A STATE PORT OR HARBOR OPERATED
27 BY A STATE PORT AUTHORITY, WITHOUT PRIOR EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE
28 LEGISLATURE; TO AMEND SECTIONS 19-3-40 AND 21-17-5, MISSISSIPPI
29 CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
31 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
32 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all the deadlines and
33 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
34 the purpose of requesting the drafting, and the introduction,
35 consideration and passage, of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND
36 SECTION 29-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT EXPRESS
37 APPROVAL OF THE LEGISLATURE IS REQUIRED BEFORE THE LEASE, SALE OR
38 OTHER CONVEYANCE BY A STATE PORT AUTHORITY TO A PUBLIC ENTITY OF
39 SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY ASSOCIATED WITH THE STATE
40 PORT OR HARBOR OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY; TO AMEND SECTION

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45 HARBOR; TO CREATE AN EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN NONRESIDENT ALIENS OR
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55 CONFORMITY THERETO AND TO CLARIFY THE POWERS OF THE STATE PORT
