HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 91

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO COMMEND BEST BUY COMPANY, INC., ON
2 THEIR ANNOUNCED COMMITMENT TO AN EIGHT MILLION DOLLAR "REBOOT AND
3 REBUILD" DONATION PROGRAM FOR MISSISSIPPI K-12 SCHOOLS IMPACTED BY
4 HURRICANES KATRINA AND RITA.

5 WHEREAS, Hurricanes Katrina and Rita produced enormous
6 devastation to many public schools when they slammed into the
7 Mississippi Gulf Coast in August and September 2005; and

8 WHEREAS, Best Buy Company, Inc., in acknowledging an
9 immediate need to get these schools back into condition to provide
10 education to thousands of Mississippi children, has announced its
11 commitment to an \$8 million dollar "Reboot and Rebuild" donation
12 program, including new computers, laser printers, software and
