HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 99

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE INTRODUCTION,
3 CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND
4 SECTION 27-35-143, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE TIME IN
5 WHICH A PERSON MAY APPLY TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF A COUNTY
6 AND WHEN THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY CHANGE, CANCEL OR DECREASE
7 AN ASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY FOR AD VALOREM TAXES WHENEVER THE
8 PROPERTY HAS CEASED TO EXIST OR HAS BEEN DESTROYED OR THE PROPERTY
9 HAS DEPRECIATED IN VALUE ON ACCOUNT OF FIRE, EXPLOSION, STORM,
10 FLOOD, EARTHQUAKE, LIGHTNING OR OTHER INEVITABLE ACCIDENT OR ACT
11 OF PROVIDENCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
13 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
14 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all the deadlines and
15 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
16 the purpose of requesting the drafting, and the introduction,
17 consideration and passage, of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND
18 SECTION 27-35-143, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE TIME IN
19 WHICH A PERSON MAY APPLY TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF A COUNTY
20 AND WHEN THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY CHANGE, CANCEL OR DECREASE
21 AN ASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY FOR AD VALOREM TAXES WHENEVER THE
22 PROPERTY HAS CEASED TO EXIST OR HAS BEEN DESTROYED OR THE PROPERTY
23 HAS DEPRECIATED IN VALUE ON ACCOUNT OF FIRE, EXPLOSION, STORM,
24 FLOOD, EARTHQUAKE, LIGHTNING OR OTHER INEVITABLE ACCIDENT OR ACT
25 OF PROVIDENCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
